Intent - Wisdom.

The Collect

Grant to us lord we beseech thee, the wisdom to think and do always such things as be rightful; that by thee we be enabled to live according to thy will; through Christ our Lord. Amen.

The Epistle for the 8th Sunday after Trinity is from the writings of the Master Kumara.

Here Endeth The Epistle.

The Gospel for the 8th Sunday after Trinity is from the book of the Great Logos.

Lord Jesus, said an apostle --- teach us the wisdom of the Father. Jesus bid the twelve male disciples, and also the women disciples to surround him, and promised to reveal to them the great mysteries. Jesus said --- these mysteries are to be guarded with the utmost secrecy, and revealed to none who are unworthy, neither father nor mother, nor sister nor brother, nor to any relative; neither for food nor drink, neither for gold or silver, or favours or anything of this world. Especially not to any who practice the foul arts or rites. All the mysteries Jesus promised these disciples, that they may be able to pass on these secrets and powers to those worthy of them. After these powers were passed on to all the disciples both male and female, they were given the right to pass on this Apostolic power of succession, being the guardians of the wisdom and the Christian mysteries.
