The 18th Sunday after Trinity

Green.

Intent - Christ as Truth.

Candles 6.

The Collect.

O Lord the Christ, grant that we may find strength to be true in thought, word and deed, so that we may reach you through the eternal truth, O Lord, to whom be honour and glory evermore. Amen.

The Epistle for the 18th Sunday after Trinity is from the writings of the Words of Osiris.

Planning an uncertain future is against all the rules of understanding at all levels. You of humanity are not to plan your future to the extent that you do; you are pushing your own laws through. It is much easier to obey the laws that exist in the cosmos, which cannot be improved upon anyway. Surely you can see that all your illnesses and problems are defences against the truth; and in your making your own rules a fragment of truth has pierced your own construction and brought chaos. Truth always brings chaos to untruth and the body will respond with problems of all kinds. To alleviate these problems you only have to open yourself to the truth of the cosmos and your being, which is always as God created it, that is in perfection and harmony.

The Gospel for the 18th Sunday after Trinity is from the Book of John.

Let not your hearts be troubled; ye believe in God, believe in me also. In my Father's house there are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you unto myself; that where I am, ye may also be. Jesus said --- I am the way, the truth and the life; no one comes to the Father but by me. If you know my ways, then you also know my Father's ways. Those who see me, have also seen the Father.
